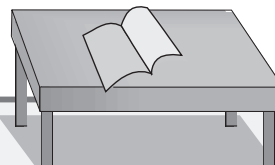

Child Development Tip

When we feed an infant we tend to feed on the side of our body that is most comfortable – usually with the head nestled in your left arm. The infant should be rotated on each side for feeding. This way the infant's eyes and ears will develop better on both sides. Make it a plan to feed on the left Monday, Wednesday and Friday and then Tuesday and Thursday feed on the right arm.

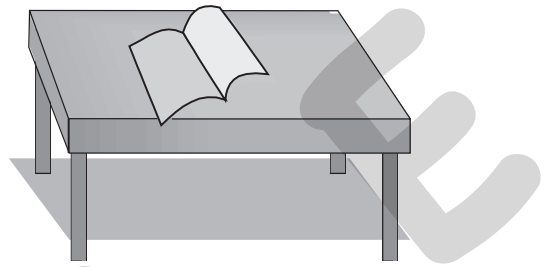
