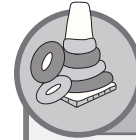
Theme: Ocean Fun

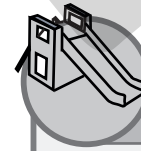

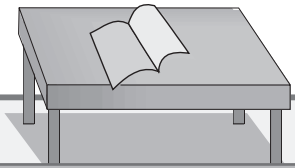

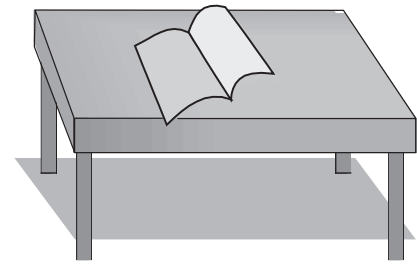

Child Development Tip - A child's eyes are not fully developed until the age of two. It is important to exercise the child's eyes by having them follow items (tracking) with their eyes up and down, close in and further out and side to side. Show the toddlers how to move a toy up and down and side to side in front of themselves.
